



Director Overview and Application Process

The Scottish Rights of Way and Access Society (ScotWays) wishes to appoint new members to its Board of Directors. ScotWays is a company limited by guarantee and the Directors are also charity trustees. ScotWays looks not only to replace retiring Directors' skills and knowledge but also to broaden its base of director expertise.

ScotWays is an independent charity dedicated to upholding public access to land in Scotland. It provides information on all aspects of access and associated amenity rights. It undertakes projects to improve and promote responsible access to land and water for walkers, cyclists, horse riders and others. ScotWays is the keeper of the National Catalogue of Rights of Way and publishes guides to specific routes as well as guidance to the law.

ScotWays' Directors have collective responsibility for the oversight and development of the charity in conformity with OSCR regulations and applicable law. The Directors agree strategy and governance arrangements and work with professional staff to deliver ScotWays' services efficiently and effectively. The role of a director is set out in the attached document and referred to in the Articles of Association.

- Knowledge of Scotland's outdoor places
- Strategic management skills

Directors are not remunerated and your contribution will be on a voluntary/pro bono basis, although out of pocket expenses are reimbursed.
